

Call to Artists for Exhibition Season 2011

The Carnegie Visual and Performing Arts Center is dedicated to showcasing the works of emerging and established artists in all disciplines. The Carnegie is located in Covington, KY, ten blocks south from the Ohio River and downtown Cincinnati, OH. Each year, 30-40 group and solo shows are awarded for the five galleries consisting of 6,000 square feet of exhibition space.

Eligibility Any artist(s) living in the United States. All styles and media are eligible. Note: Any artist who has been awarded a solo show at The Carnegie must wait 3 years to apply again. You may, however, apply for group and theme shows during that period.

Submissions **Solo Exhibition** - 10 images of a consistent body of work in JPEG format provided on CD (see below for image details; CD will not be returned), \$25 entry fee (Carnegie members \$20 entry fee), and attached application form.

Group Exhibition (2 or more artists) - 20 images representing all artists who will be showing in the exhibition, \$40 entry fee (Carnegie members \$35 entry fee), attached application form, a one-page typed statement may be submitted to better understand the purpose or details of the show. Please use one contact person.

Art of Food - This year we are asking artists or teams of artists to submit proposals of art created from food or art that carries a food theme. A simple drawing and a short written statement on the proposed creation is all that is necessary, but you may elaborate however you wish. Proposals that are selected will be prominently displayed. The Carnegie will assist securing whatever products are needed to make the creation, artist(s) are responsible for the making and transporting of their piece.

Image Submission All images submitted should be JPEG, approximately 5"x7", 300dpi, RGB color mode, with the following information typed in a Word document included on the disc:
1. Title of Piece 2. Artist Name 3. Dimension 4. Media

Calendar May 1, 2010 Postmark deadline, all entries due
May 30, 2010 Notification of jury results mailed

Selection Artists Selected by Jurors - Each year three jurors are selected who independently evaluate the work submitted for solo and group shows. Scores are then combined from individual ratings of the jurors. The top scoring artists are awarded show contracts for the upcoming season. Artists who are awarded shows will be notified by mail. A contract will shortly follow outlining details of your show. **Please note: Artists are responsible for the transportation, installation and removal of their work, if awarded a show.**
